From Portland:

- Travel east on Interstate 84 to Interstate 82 (Exit #179). Go north on I-82 to Kennewick.
- As you traverse through the Tri-Cities, follow the signs to Spokane.
- Take Hwy 395 north through Kennewick; cross bridge to Pasco.
- Proceed east through Pasco on Interstate 182.
- Turn onto Hwy 395 (to Spokane) at the intersection of I-182, Hwy 12, and 395.
- Travel north on Hwy 395 to the intersection of Hwy 395 and Hwy 26.
- Head east on Hwy 26 to Colfax.
- Turn south onto Hwy 195 at Colfax.
- Pullman is 17 miles south of Colfax on Hwy 195. The exit to Pullman is clearly marked.
- When you come down the hill into Pullman, make a right hand turn at the first light. The street is Grand Avenue.
- At the second light, take a left hand turn onto a one way street (Paradise). The sign there says "to WSU".
- Follow this street (it curves around and becomes a two way, then crosses a bridge) until you get to the first traffic light after the bridge. Make a left hand turn here, the street is Stadium Way.
- Follow Stadium Way to traffic light at Grimes Way and turn right.
- Take the second right hand turn onto Ott Road (brown sign on corner that says Veterinary Hospital).
- Follow this driveway to the clinic parking lot, then enter the front doors to the reception area.

For large animal parking, pass the first parking lot and go straight through the gates. Trailer parking is on the left hand side. All other vehicles may park in the lot in front of the main hospital.
